Policies & Procedures

Payment of Fees:

Payments may also be made by using a **CREDIT/DEBIT CARD** or having an **AUTOMATIC DRAFT** taken out of a banking account. The costume deposits of \$30 (Oct 1 & Nov 1) and Recital fee of \$25 (May 1) will be automatically withdrawn unless other arrangements are made. The balance on all costumes will be posted by Dec. 15 and must be paid by Feb 1. All returned checks or denied debit cards will be charged a \$15 NSF fee. If these payment methods are unavailable, **MONTHLY CASH PAYMENTS** may be arranged. First & last month tuition, costume fees and recital fee will be due at registration. A \$3 processing fee per month is added to each tuition payment. Any payments paid after 15th of the month for these students, will be charged a \$15 late fee.

Withdrawals and Refunds:

There is a two-month minimum for all lessons. One-month notice before the 7th of the month is required to discontinue any classes. No withdrawals will be accepted after March 7. Withdrawal can not be accepted over the phone. To withdraw from classes a parent or adult student must:

1. Inform NADT Dance Academy administration in person
2. Complete and sign a withdrawal form provided by the school office.

All unprocessed checks dated after the one-month notice period will be returned. No refunds will be given for costume fees after Nov. 1 or for recital fee after March 1. Dancers that drop out of recital forfeit their costume.

Our goal is to keep dancers dancing!

Drop Off & Pick Up: Parents of very small children (5 & under) stay in the lobby until the children are escorted to their classroom. Please be in the lobby 5 minutes before class is over so that your child can go directly to you when the teachers bring them out of class. You are welcome to stay in the lobby the entire class period. No child is to wait outside for their parent.

Remember class space is limited, **Enroll NOW** to be sure of your placement in the classes of your choice!
